What workers say...



Approximately **one-third** of workers in high hazard industries do not believe safety is valued

50% say safety meetings are held less often than they should be

39% think management does the minimum required by law to keep employees safe

36% say safety takes a backseat to completing job tasks

30% say they are too afraid to report safety issues

An effective safety and health program can save
\$4-\$6 for every \$1 invested



Organizations with higher engagement scores had
70% fewer safety incidents
compared to those with low engagement.

Quick Tips for Employers

- ▶ **Prioritize safety:** Have protocols in place. No shortcuts!
- ▶ **Reduce stress:** Ensure employees aren't overtaxed
- ▶ **Train everyone:** Educate on all risks & procedures
- ▶ **Request input:** Give employees a voice in the safety program
- ▶ **Use leading indicators:** Track systems, operations & behavior



Quick Tips for Employees

- ▶ **Stay alert:** Be aware of your surroundings at all times
- ▶ **Dress for safety:** Always wear, clean & maintain your PPE
- ▶ **Use the right tools:** Know your tools & machines thoroughly
- ▶ **Love your body:** Take breaks & maintain correct posture
- ▶ **Be diligent:** Report violations & unsafe conditions



Stats that Prove Digital Signage Works

- » Digital signs capture **400% more views** than static signs
- » People process visuals **60,000x faster** than text
- » **63%** of people say digital signs capture their attention
- » Messages on digital signs have a **recall rate of 83%**
- » Digital signage for safety **reduces workplace injury by 20%**

Benefits of Digital Signage Over Printed Signs

- * **Eye-catching:** bright, animated screens draw attention
- * **More real estate:** show more messages, more often
- * **Centralized:** manage messages & schedules from a single app
- * **Targeted:** assign different messages to different screens
- * **Immediate updates:** schedule & publish in minutes
- * **Emergency alerts:** override every screen or selected screens
